

Non-Vendor use of market space
(Non-Profits and PR) application

2011 Market Manager Caroline Wood is seeking community building opportunities for local non-profits, health education, music, and talent. Your acceptance to the market is driven by our belief in enhancing our market. If at any time your presence detracts from the Market experience of either vendor or customer (aside from personal disagreement with your message or cause)...we may ask you to peaceably leave the premise.

Our hope is that your involvement will give you exposure, promote awareness, and build community. Building healthy communities is the foundation of the markets purpose so at such time the relationship becomes unhealthy our termination of your participation may be necessary.

Rules

1. You may pleasantly greet and speak with market-goers. No direct solicitation of customers is allowed.
2. Display of your organization sign or business is required and if customers ask for more information; then you may share anything you have with them i.e. business cards, leaflets, pamphlets, etc...
3. No selling on site is allowed unless it is a non-compete item such as a music CD and you have shown your tax ID number for sales. Selling onsite requires a 25\$ stall rental fee which may be waived at our discretion should it be mutually beneficial. Otherwise make off site sale arrangements email, internet, etc...
4. We support the right to individual freedoms, but please respect the "Market" is not a forum for political, religious, or doctrinal debate. Your inclusion at the market does not constitute our endorsement/support of your organization, party, business, etc...
5. If anything other than table and chair is required; prior approval is necessary due to safety, liability, and space constraints. Tents if approved must be properly weighted due to winds/safety.
6. Larger participation "group" use of market – parking must not be in customer parking area but in Madison east lot. Customers have priority.
7. If a vendor has personally invited you, you may share their stall or space.
8. All non-vendors must coordinate market appearances prior to the date of attendance to ensure space, location, and market saturation do not occur, as well as balance and equitability.

Vendor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Mankato Farmers' Market and Mankato Area Growers Association, its' employees and volunteers, from any and all causes of action which may arise from the operation of this Farmers Market, not caused by negligence of said parties. Attached is a copy of insurance covering 1400 Madison East Mankato MN 56001. *I grant permission for Mankato Farmers' Market to use any photos, videos, etc.. in publicity and advertising promotions.* By signing this application I acknowledge that the agreement has been read and understood, and I and participating members will abide by the terms presented in this agreement.
